

BOILERMAKER TRACK TO TEACHING

A QUICK AND CLEAR PATH TO TEACHER LICENSURE FOR CURRENT UNDERGRADUATES

The Boilermaker Track to Teaching (BTT) program gives current undergraduates an additional career option; a head start on earning their teaching credentials. It is designed for juniors or seniors who are exploring the possibility of teaching or for students in programs without a teacher education option. Open to most majors on campus, BTT will lead to an Indiana secondary (grades 5-12) teaching license. The program will not delay undergraduate time-to-degree and could be combined with Degree in Three plans. Think of BTT as a 3+1 or 4+1 option for an additional professional credential.



During the certification year of BTT, candidates can teach full-time in Indiana on a Transition to Teaching (T2T) permit at the arrangement of the candidate and hiring school. Coursework for the program is available entirely online, so students can choose where to work and live while completing the program so long as their teaching internship takes place in an accredited school. It is also possible to dovetail the coursework for the program with a master's degree from Purdue.

Purdue's College of Education aims to alleviate the teacher shortage while providing an additional career option for all Boilermakers.
