

CPR/AED Training and Certification Purdue University Teacher Education Fall 2023

The Office of Teacher Education and Licensure (OTEL) and the Purdue University Fire Department (PUFD) are offering CPR/AED training and certification for Purdue University Teacher Education undergraduate students. CPR/AED training and eventual certification are requirements set forth by the Indiana Department of Education (IDOE) for all educators and Teacher Education candidates prior to licensure. Training and Registration

The training will be delivered in a 2-part, “blended” format, with the first portion of the training delivered online by the American Heart Association (AHA), and upon completion, a second in-person, hands-on training session conducted by the Purdue University Fire Department. **TWO consecutive registrations** are required for training and certification. Plan to complete the second registration immediately following the first. The first registration is for the online portion of the training via the [AHA registration link](#). The [second registration](#) is for the in-person, hands-on training session with the Purdue University Fire Department.

Upon completion of the online training, students **MUST** download the completion certificate and email it to Assistant Chief Kevin Luse at kluse@purdue.edu. Students will **not** be allowed to complete the skills session without having emailed the online completion certificate. The in-person training **cannot** be completed prior to the online training. Content/material from the online training session will be referenced and required to pass during the in-person training.

Location and Time

All in-person training sessions will begin promptly at 5:00 pm (EST) at 1250 Third St, Purdue Fire Station. Parking is available in the COREC lots, which are north of the fire station. Only nine (9) seats are available for each in-person, hands-on training. Should an emergency arise, you **MUST** cancel your in-person training following the instructions provided at the bottom of the [registration page](#). Otherwise, once registered, your attendance is anticipated and expected by the instructor.

The only cost to Purdue University Teacher Education undergraduate students is the AHA online course, which is \$16.00 (*paid directly online to AHA*). The cost of the in-person, hands-on training and CPR/AED certification will be covered by Purdue University, College of Education.
