The full BFTF application package includes:

- 1. Application.
- 2. Your resume or list of activities, projects, or experiences.
- 3.Essay about yourself.
- 4. Video (preferably) or essay with a response to the prompt.
- 5.Letter of recommendation.
- 6.ANY additional evidence that demonstrates your interest and willingness to participate in the Institute. Such evidence may include but is not limited to diplomas, certificates, letters of support, articles in newspapers, letters from peers or superiors, etc.
